Sioux Falls sits at the junction of interstates 90 (running east-west) and 29 (running north-south). The Interstate 229 loop bypasses the city's business district, allowing quick access to any destination in Sioux Falls. Sioux Area Metro is the city bus system, with stops throughout town and at most attractions. All buses are wheelchair accessible, providing easy access for all travelers.



NATURAL PLAYGROUNDS

Set Out to Explore the Natural Wonders in and Around the City


Brimming with prairie grasslands, rolling hills, and lofty canyons, South Dakota is a gem for anyone with a desire to explore the great outdoors. The getaway for all of these natural wonders? Sioux Falls, with must-see outdoor destinations found within and around the city. Between hiking, wildlife-spotting, skiing, and more, South Dakota's largest city is chock-full of outdoor marvels to explore, including these extraordinary parks, trails, and natural areas.



FALLS PARK

Ever wonder how Sioux Falls got its name? Well. wonder no more with a visit to Falls Park, the 128acre park punctuated with striking waterfalls that inspired the name of this fair city. Conveniently located right in the action of downtown, the park gives a bird's-eye view of the impressive tiered falls with the help of viewing platforms, including a five-story observation tower.

Beyond the Falls, there's no shortage of things to do within this stunning park. For instance, there's the Falls Park Farmers Market, held May through October and packed with the freshest fruits and veggies around. Grab a bite at the Falls Overlook Cafe, where you'll get the best seat overlooking the falls as you nibble on light fare like soups, salads, and, of course, locally made ice cream. Take a



two-wheeled tour of the city by bicycle on the Big Sioux River Recreation Trail and Greenway, which encompasses The Falls (more on that later). You can also view creative sculptures, amble along the paths, and enjoy a playground with your little ones.



GOOD EARTH STATE PARK AT BLOOD RUN

Only a few miles from Sioux Falls lies the state's latest and greatest state park: Good Earth State Park at Blood Run, established in 2013. With the Big Sioux River coursing through the 588-acre expanse on its way to lowa, there are plenty of offerings for outdoor enthusiasts here, including hiking trails with scenic overlooks and wildlife viewing.

But the history of this land sets it apart and garnered it recognition as a National Historic Landmark. Evidence shows that this area is one of the country's oldest sites of long-term human settlement. Don't miss the Visitor Center, where you can learn so much more about this fascinating area.

GREAT BEAR RECREATION PARK

If you like outdoor fun of the winter variety, you're in luck with Great Bear Recreation Park. It boasts more than 200 acres, and its Ski Valley is especially famed for its opportunities to make the most out of winter. Think: tubing, skiing, snowshoeing, and snowboarding, all enjoyed on 14 downhill trails, a quad chairlift, and four miles of groomed crosscountry trails. Although South

Dakota is often associated with being a winter paradise, it may surprise you to know that Great Bear Recreation Park is the only ski and snowboarding area in the eastern section of the state.

Perhaps you prefer warmer temperatures? If so, you'll be glad to know that the park's fourmile trail system that's so great for cross-country skiing in the winter is also fabulous for walking to witness the area's natural splendor. The native plant display is something to behold.



PLAY AT A PARK

With more than 80 city parks offering hiking, biking, water play, history, and more, you'll never be far from outdoor fun when visiting the city. Bring your wheels-skateboards, inline skates, and BMX bikes-to cruise the bowl, ramps, and rails at Barb Iverson Skate Plaza, one of the largest skate parks in the country. And opening in 2025. Jacobson Plaza at The Falls promises fun for everyone in the family, with an ice skating ribbon, allinclusive playground, dog park, and more. BIG SIOUX RIVER RECREATION TRAIL & GREENWAY

Maybe biking tops your list whenever you're visiting a new place. If so, you'll want to check out the Big Sioux River Recreation Trail and Greenway, a 36-mile trail that follows the Big Sioux River and winds throughout the city.

This is a paved, pleasantly smooth way to take in the scenery and the wildlife of the area. Even better? It's use is not limited to biking. You can skate, run, and walk year-round on the well-maintained trails. This is the perfect way to see all that Sioux Falls has to offer, from Falls Park to city views to riverside sights.



PALISADES STATE PARK

About a half-hour drive from Sioux Falls, you'll discover Palisades State Park—an expansive 167-acre park spotlighting natural spectacles you won't see anywhere else.

Flowing through the park, Split Rock Creek is flanked by stunning 50-foot, 1.2-billion-

year-old Sioux quartzite formations that exemplify the area's natural beauty. It should come as no surprise that rock climbers flock to this area to tackle the formations. Hiking trails beckon to explorers, and the state park also plays host to anyone who loves to bike, fish, camp, or geocache.





The park features a world-class visitor center with an exhibit and film that focuses on the Native American culture that has existed in this area for hundreds of years. In addition to the unique cultural history, Good Earth State Park offers an opportunity to get out and experience nature with over 10 miles of trails through tallgrass prairie, woodlands, and river bottom along the Big Sioux River.

■ PALISADES STATE PARK

Admire the 50-foot Sioux quartzite cliffs towering over Split Rock Creek. The State Park expanded in 2024, adding more campsites and a new entrance southwest of Garretson. Modern camping facilities and cabins are also available for visitors.

DEVIL'S GULCH

Explore Split Rock Creek's wooded red quartzite canyons, where Jesse James' horse leapt to help him escape in 1876. Hike scenic trails to Devil's Falls and the Devil's Stairway, or enjoy a Jesse James Pontoon ride through the gorge.

SPLIT ROCK PARK

Only a short walk from Devil's Gulch and Downtown Garretson, launch your kayak, fish, camp, and play at Split Rock Park. Enjoy beautiful views of three unique bridges, a waterfall, and an old Sioux Quartzite visitor center.

This tropical-oasis-in-a-city features hundreds of butterflies fluttering around a waterfall and koi pond. Purchase a butterfly feeder when you get there to attract the delicate insects as you explore. The building also houses the Aquarium Gallery, where families have a close-up view of stingrays, colorful coral, and exotic sea life from around the world. Don't skip the touch tank and Discover Den with hands-on activities for young children.

The **Great Plains Zoo's** exciting new lion habitat recently opened, so be among the first to marvel at lions and meerkats in one of the largest species-specific habitats in North America. Save plenty of time to see the rest of the zoo, though. There are snow monkeys, as well as bison, bears, giraffes, red wolves, and so much more. Exhibits like the kangaroo enclosure and farm area allow visitors to get extra close to the animals. Exclusive experiences are available for reservation: feed a rhino, observe a big cat training demonstration, or go behind the scenes to meet the zoo's bison and miniature horse. Don't forget to bring swimsuits and towels. The zoo's splash pad is included with admission.





igns of Sioux Falls' early days of European settlement can be seen throughout the city. Historic homes and commercial buildings feature the pink glow of locally quarried quartzite, an occasional cross-cut slab of petrified wood, and the remnants of early industries, such as the Oueen Bee Mill at Falls Park. Here's where you can find slices of Sioux Falls history.

Pettigrew Home & Museum

Pettigrew Home & Museum

During his time in this grand home, Richard F. Pettigrew convinced an East Coast investor to finance the seven-story, 1,200-barrels-per-day Queen Bee flour mill along the Big Sioux River. He harnessed hydropower for the mill and possibly used it to slice petrified wood—a trend among America's up-and-coming millionaires. You can see petrified wood on the home's exterior, then tour inside exhibits of the family's artifacts collected from around the world in conjunction with displays on the region's natural history and Native American cultures.

Old Courthouse Museum

This massive stone building with stained-glass windows and 16 murals from the 1910s served as the Minnehaha County courthouse from 1890 to 1962. Three floors of exhibits bring to life the history of early settlers and the Plains

Indians, along with rotating exhibits. The museum's gift shop sells local and regional books, crafts, oldfashioned tous, holiday collectibles. souvenirs, and exhibit-related items.

Center for Western Studies

2111

This repository, located next to Augustana University's Mikkelsen Library, preserves and interprets the history and cultures of indigenous tribes and early European immigrants through exhibits and a library with more than 37,000 volumes on the American West. The center also brings together more than two dozen artists who reflect the region through sculpture, ceramics, paintings, photos, and mixed media for the annual Artists of the Plains Art Show and Sale.

Cathedral of Saint Joseph

This magnificent Romanesque and French Renaissance church opened in 1919. On a selfguided tour get a look at the massive pipe organ in the choir loft and the marble altar.

Mary Jo Wegner Arboretum & East Sioux Falls Historic Site

Visitors to this scenic destination can explore remnants from East Sioux Falls' early days as a quarry town, hike through 155 acres of native landscape, see a replicated 1888 Illinois Central Railroad Depot, or take a class in a re-creation of the town's L-shaped schoolhouse.

East Sioux Falls Historic Site welcomes visitors to its 155-acre site. The Mabel and Judy Jasper Educational Center features a historical classroom as well as meeting rooms and event space for rentals including indoor and outdoor weddings.

A SALUTE TO VETERANS

Sioux Falls features several sites that commemorate military sacrifice and service.



The USS South Dakota Battleship Memorial is a powerful tribute, with a concrete outline of the vessel that gives visitors a way to grasp the immense size of World War II's most-decorated battleship. The USS South Dakota and its crew fought in every major battle in the Pacific from 1942 to 1945. The museum, which is planning an expansion,

offers exhibits on life aboard the ship and stories about crew members who didn't make it home.

The 22-acre Veterans' Memorial Park, built on the site of a former World War II Army Air Corps training base, welcomes visitors with flags, poignant sculptures, historic displays, a memorial wall, and the Medal of Honor Garden. Walking paths along Covell Lake, benches, and an amphitheater provide places to honor and remember veterans of multiple wars.

Established in 2021. South Dakota Veterans Cemetery is the first federally funded stateowned-and-operated cemetery in South Dakota. It encompasses 60 rolling acres on the northern edge of Sioux Falls and north of Interstate 90.

the state's premier performing arts organization. The SDSO curates a diverse collection of orchestral offerings each season through classical and pops concerts, as well as chamber music, appealing to very experienced audiences and first timers. Performances occur October through April in the Washington Pavilion.
